Professor Maria Herrera-Sobek (Ph.D., UC Los Angeles) is the Associate Vice Chancellor for Diversity, Equity, and Academic Policy and Professor in the Department of Chicana and Chicano Studies where she holds the Luis Leal Endowed Chair. Her most recent book is *Chicano Folklore: A Handbook* (2006). She has also published more than 130 articles in journals and anthologies. Her current projects include Editor of the *Encyclopedia for Latino Folklore* and a book-length study on the Virgin of Guadalupe, La Llorona, and La Malinche in art and literature. In addition to scholarly publications, her poetry has been widely published in numerous journals and in the poetry collection *Three Times a Woman*. Professor Herrera-Sobek also recently received the "Distinguished Alumnus Award for 2007" from the UCLA Spanish and Portuguese Department.
