Paula Rudolph began her career at UCSB as the first full-time Executive Director of the Associated Students. Paula received her PhD in Counseling Psychology from the Gevirtz Graduate School of Education in 1981. Since that time she spent 12 years as the Assistant Dean of the Graduate Division and subsequently 16 years as UCSB's first full-time Sexual Harassment and Title IX Complaint Resolution Officer. Several common threads through all of Paula's positions have been creative problem-solving, leadership, and empowering individuals, especially women, to achieve their personal and career potentials. Since 1991 she has handled over 900 complaints of sexual harassment at UCSB. Come hear about some of the forces that led Paula to be a pioneer in her current career and some of the more interesting challenges she has faced along her journey.
